FRUIT	Fruit Fly	2 ml/1 l water + 80 g sugar or 2 ml protein or 6 g fish oil	Bait treatment. Apply 35 – 40 ℓ /ha as a coarse droplet spray onto underside of foliage. For small plots, repeat application twice per week. For large plots repeat application weekly and after rain.
PUBLIC HEALTH	Carpet Beetles, Flies, Ants, Bedbugs, Cockroaches, Fish moths	50 ml /1l water	Coarse spray or brush onto surfaces.
