### SYMPTOMS OF POISONING

### **FIRST AID TREATMENT**

Remove the victim from the area of exposure. Wash off remaining material with plenty of water. In the event of any complaints or symptoms, avoid further exposure and consult a doctor. Inhalation: If vapours or mists have been inhaled, move victim to fresh air and remove source of contamination if safe to do so. The patient should be kept under observation. Only qualified personnel should perform administration of oxygen. Obtain medical attention if symptoms persist.

### IMPORTANT NOTES:

- Spraying directly onto, or spray drift settling on desirable plants, can result in serious injury to the plants.
- When applying KOMBAT WIPE-OUT for the purpose of soil preparation for transplant of tomatoes, or any transplanted crop with soft green stems, allow a minimum of 2 weeks to elapse between application and transplanting.
- Do not store, mix or apply KOMBAT WIPE-OUT solutions in galvanised steel or unlined steel (except stainless steel) containers or spray tanks. KOMBAT WIPE-OUT can react with such containers and produce hydrogen gas, which may form a highly combustible and explosive gas mixture.
- Store in a well-ventilated place in the original container, keeping it tightly closed and secured.
- After application, clean applicator thoroughly and dispose of wash water where it will not harm other plants. Destroy empty container and do not use for any other purpose.

### **General Information:**

- · KOMBAT WIPE-OUT is a non-selective systemic herbicide and is only active when applied to
- the foliage and green bark of plants.
- KOMBAT WIPE-OUT has little or no activity in the soil. Repeated applications may be necessary to control weeds germinating from seeds.
- KOMBAT WIPE-OUT should only be applied to actively growing weeds.
- Use only clean water with no suspended soil particles in spray mixture.
- · Always ensure that spray equipment is clean, free from sediments or rust.
- Ensure even droplet coverage of all weeds.
- Rain or irrigation within 3 hours of application can reduce the efficacy of KOMBAT WIPE-OUT.
- The visible effect of KOMBAT WIPE-OUT on treated foliage usually appears at 7 10 days after treatment but may vary according to weather conditions.

### **Use restrictions:**

- Spray onto target weeds only, avoid contact of spray droplets with desirable vegetation.
- KOMBAT WIPE-OUT is actively absorbed through immature bark and leaves of most plants and trees. Contact with immature bark, such as in trees younger than three years, can result in serious localised or translocated damage.
- Allow 10 days to elapse after pruning when spraying KOMBAT WIPE-OUT close to pruned trees or shrubs, in order to allow the wounds to dry completely.
- Do not spray on weed foliage covered with a layer of dust. In these situations, apply after recent rain or irrigation.

### **Application guidelines:**

- Use low spray pressure when spraying to avoid spray drift of fine droplets.
- Do not apply KOMBAT WIPE-OUT to weeds that are covered with dew, or in a dormant growth
- phase or under stress conditions e.g., moisture, heat or cold stress.
- Perennial weeds must be sprayed upon flower initiation or between mid-summer to early autumn.
- Certain perennial weeds may require follow up spraying onto regrowth.
- Sprayed plants must die off first before cultivation of the soil.
- To avoid subsequent injury to plant growth, clean application equipment and protective equipment thoroughly immediately after spraying by thoroughly flushing with water.

### GARDEN, HOME & SMALL HOLDER APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS:

One Liter of spay mixture must be sprayed on an area covered with weeds of not less than 10 m<sup>2</sup>. A spray solution of 1 % [10  $\ell$  of spray mixture] should be sufficient to control weeds in a 100 m<sup>2</sup> area.
